#### iPhone or iPad (iOS mobile) Device

You have the ability to access your hosted RDP session from your iOS mobile device. To access the RDP environment from your iOS mobile device, you will need to download the Windows App Mobile app (previously Remote Desktop app). The following steps will instruct you on how to access your session using the Windows App Mobile app.

1. From the App Store on your Apple device, search for the **Windows App Mobile** app. The developer is Microsoft Corporation.



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- 2. Select **Get**, and then select **Install**.
- 3. Open the Windows App Mobile app on your Apple device.
- 4. From the bottom of right-side of the screen, select **Apps**.



5. From the upper-right side of the Apps screen, click the + sign.



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5. From the Add screen, select Workspace.

- 9. Select Next.
- 10. The app will be "Setting up Workspaces" and then you should see your Work Resources (AdminSet (if applicable to your cloud profile), CenterPoint, File Explorer, and other applicable applications) loaded on the Apps screen.
- 11. From the Work Resources screen, select your CenterPoint product you want to access from Red Wing Cloud Services.

## Mac OS X

You have the ability to access your hosted RDP session from a Mac OS X. To access the RDP environment from a Mac OS X, you will need to download the Windows App (Previously Remote Desktop) from the App store. The following steps will instruct you on how to access your session using the Windows app.

1. Form the Mac App Store on your device, search for the Windows App .



2. Download and install the Windows App.



- 3. From the left side of the screen, select Apps.
- 4. From the top right side of the screen, click the + dropdown and select Add Workspace.



5. On the Add Workspace screen, enter the https://centerpoint.redwingcloud.com/rdweb/feed/webfeed.aspx URL.

### Android

1. From the App Store on your Android device, search for the **Windows App** app. The developer is Microsoft Corporation.





- 2. Open the **Windows App** app on your device.
- 3. Click the + in the top right of the first displayed screen.



- 4. Select Workspace.
- 5. Select OK.
- In the Workspace URL box, enter <u>https://centerpoint.redwingcloud.com/rdweb/feed/webfeed.aspx</u> and select Next.

#### Q: My User name and Password are not working, what should I do?

A: If your User name and Password are not working:

- 1. From your web browser enter https://centerpoint.redwingcloud.com.
- 2. Enter the user@company (login) and Password.
- 3. Click Sign In.

    - Click and then enter your User name and current Password. Then, type in your new password twice and click Submit.
      - Passwords must be a minimum of 10 characters.
      - » Passwords must not contain the owners name.
      - » Passwords must contain at least one character from three of the four categories below:

        - Lower case letters
        - Numbers
        - Non-alphanumeric characters: ~!@#\$%^&\*\_-+=`|\(){{[]:;"<>,.?/
